4	JURISDICTION
5	3. When deemed by the Bureau Chief to be in the public interest, the Bureau Chief has
6	the authority under Business and Professions Code section 11315.5 to enter into a settlement
.7 .8	related to administrative allegation of violation of the Real Estate Appraisers' Licensing and

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Certification Law or regulations promulgated pursuant thereto, upon any terms and conditions as the Bureau Chief deems appropriate.

The administrative allegation of violation against Respondent is attached as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein hy reference.

ADVISEMENT AND WAIVERS

- Respondent has carefully read and understands the charges and allegations in the 5. administrative allegation of violation. Respondent has also carefully read and understands the effects of this Stipulated Surrender.
- Respondent is fully aware of its legal rights in this matter, including the right to a 6. hearing on the administrative allegation of violation; the right to be represented by counsel at its own expense; the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against it; the right to present evidence and to testify on its own behalf; the right to the issuance of subpoenas to compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of documents; the right to reconsideration and court review of an adverse decision; and all other rights accorded by the California Administrative Procedure Act and other applicable laws.
- Respondent voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently waives and gives up each and 7. every right set forth above.

CONTINGENCY

This Stipulated Surrender shall be subject to approval by the Bureau Chief. 8. Respondent understands and agrees that counsel for Complainant and Complainant's staff may communicate directly with the Bureau Chief regarding this Stipulated Surrender, without notice to or participation by Respondent or its counsel. By signing this Stipulated Surrender, Respondent understands and agrees that it may not withdraw its agreement or seek to rescind this Stipulated Surrender prior to the time the Bureau Chief considers and acts upon it. If the Bureau Chief fails to adopt this Stipulated Surrender, the Stipulated Surrender shall be of no force or effect, and, except for this paragraph, it shall be inadmissible in any legal action between the parties, and the Bureau Chief shall not be disqualified from further action by having considered this matter.

- 9. The parties understand and agree that Portable Document Format ("PDF") or facsimile copies of this Stipulated Surrender, including PDF or facsimile signatures thereto, shall have the same force and effect as the originals.
- 10. This Stipulated Surrender is intended by the parties to be an integrated writing representing the complete, final, and exclusive embodiment of their agreement. It supersedes any and all prior or contemporaneous agreements, understandings, discussions, negotiations, and commitments (written or oral). This Stipulated Surrender may not be altered, amended, modified, supplemented, or otherwise changed except by a writing executed by an authorized representative of each of the parties.
- 11. The parties agree the Bureau Chief may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the following Order:

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respondent's Registration No. 1281 is surrendered and accepted by the Chief of the Bureau of Real Estate Appraisers. Respondent shall lose all rights and privileges as a Registered Appraisal Management Company in California as of the effective date of the Chief's Decision and Order.

ACCEPTANCE

I have carefully read the above Stipulated Surrender. I understand the stipulation and the effect it will have on my Registration. I enter into this Stipulated Surrender voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently, and agree to be bound by the Decision and Order of the Bureau Chief.
