On or about June 28, 2016, the Bureau issued Appraisal Management Company 25 Registration Number 1377 to Respondent. Respondent's Registration was in full force and effect 26 at all times relevant to the attached administrative allegation of violation and unless renewed will 27 expire on June 29, 2018. 28

CULPABILITY

- 10. Respondent admits the truth of each and every administrative allegation of violation attached as Exhibit "A", and agrees that cause exists for discipline against its Registration.
- 11. Respondent agrees that its Registration is subject to discipline and it agrees to be bound by the Bureau Chief's imposition of discipline as set forth in the following Disciplinary Order.

CONTINGENCY

- 12. This Stipulated Surrender shall be subject to approval by the Bureau Chief.

 Respondent understands and agrees that counsel for Complainant and Complainant's staff may communicate directly with the Bureau Chief regarding this Stipulated Surrender, without notice to or participation by Respondent or its counsel. By signing this Stipulated Surrender, Respondent understands and agrees that it may not withdraw its agreement or seek to rescind this Stipulated Surrender prior to the time the Bureau Chief considers and acts upon it. If the Bureau Chief fails to adopt this Stipulated Surrender, the Stipulated Surrender shall be of no force or effect, and, except for this paragraph, it shall be inadmissible in any legal action between the parties, and the Bureau Chief shall not be disqualified from further action by having considered this matter.
- 13. The parties understand and agree that Portable Document Format ("PDF") or facsimile copies of this Stipulated Surrender, including PDF or facsimile signatures thereto, shall have the same force and effect as the originals.
- 14. This Stipulated Surrender is intended by the parties to be an integrated writing representing the complete, final, and exclusive embodiment of their agreement. It supersedes any and all prior or contemporaneous agreements, understandings, discussions, negotiations, and commitments (written or oral). This Stipulated Surrender may not be altered, amended, modified, supplemented, or otherwise changed except by a writing executed by an authorized representative of each of the parties.

1	15. In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree that
2	the Bureau Chief may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the following
3	Disciplinary Order:
4	<u>DISCIPLINARY ORDER</u>
5	IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respondent's Registration No. 1377 is surrendered and
6	accepted by the Chief of the Bureau of Real Estate Appraisers. Respondent shall lose all rights
7	and privileges as a Registered Appraisal Management Company in California as of the effective
8	date of the Chief's Decision and Order.

10	I have carefully read the above Stipulated Surrender. I understand the stipulation and the
11	effect it will have on my Registration. I enter into this Stipulated Surrender voluntarily,
12	knowingly, and intelligently, and agree to be bound by the Decision and Order of the Bureau
